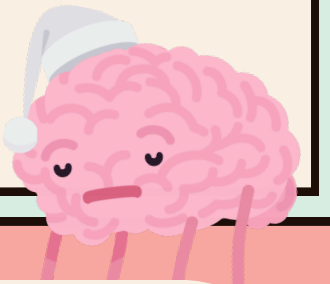
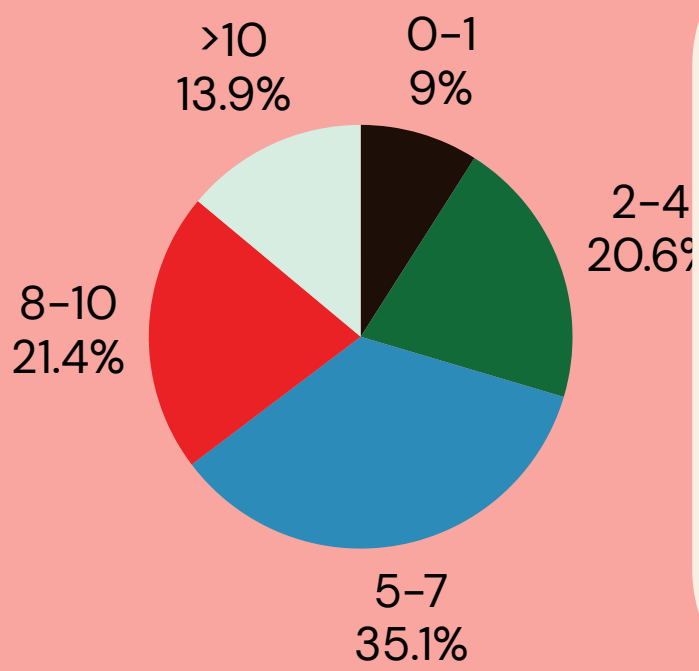


# Students are unable to submit their assignments on time!

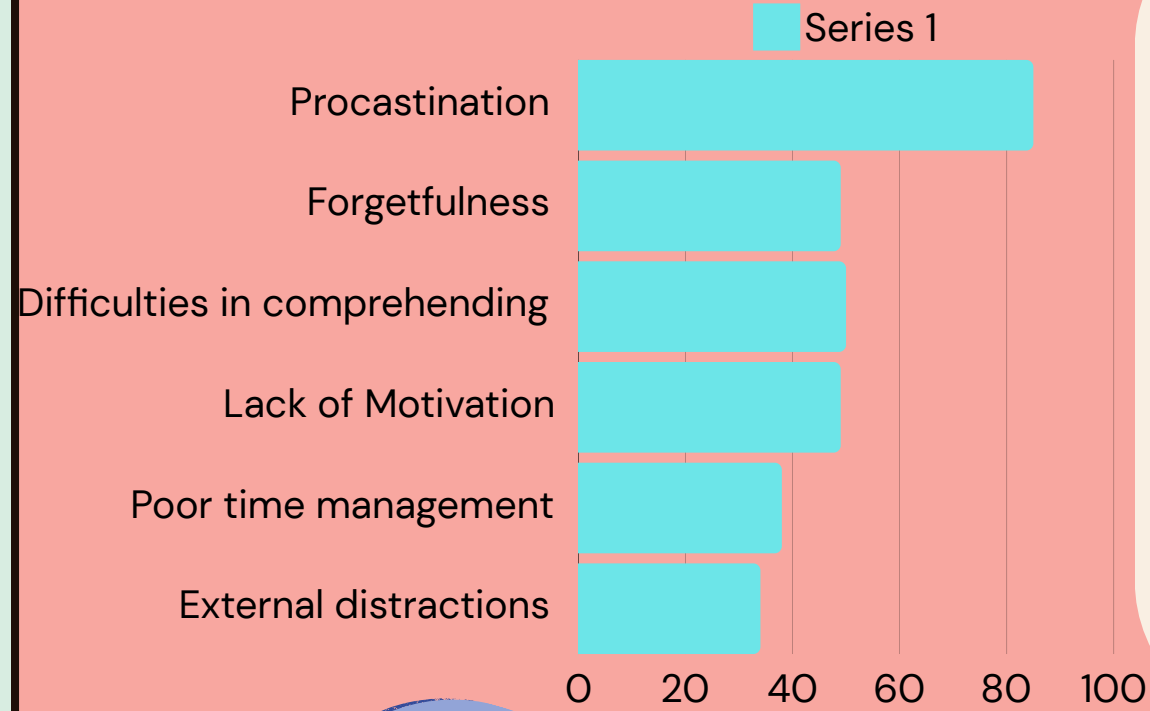


## How many pieces of homework are you able to hand in in time?

## App description (edit)

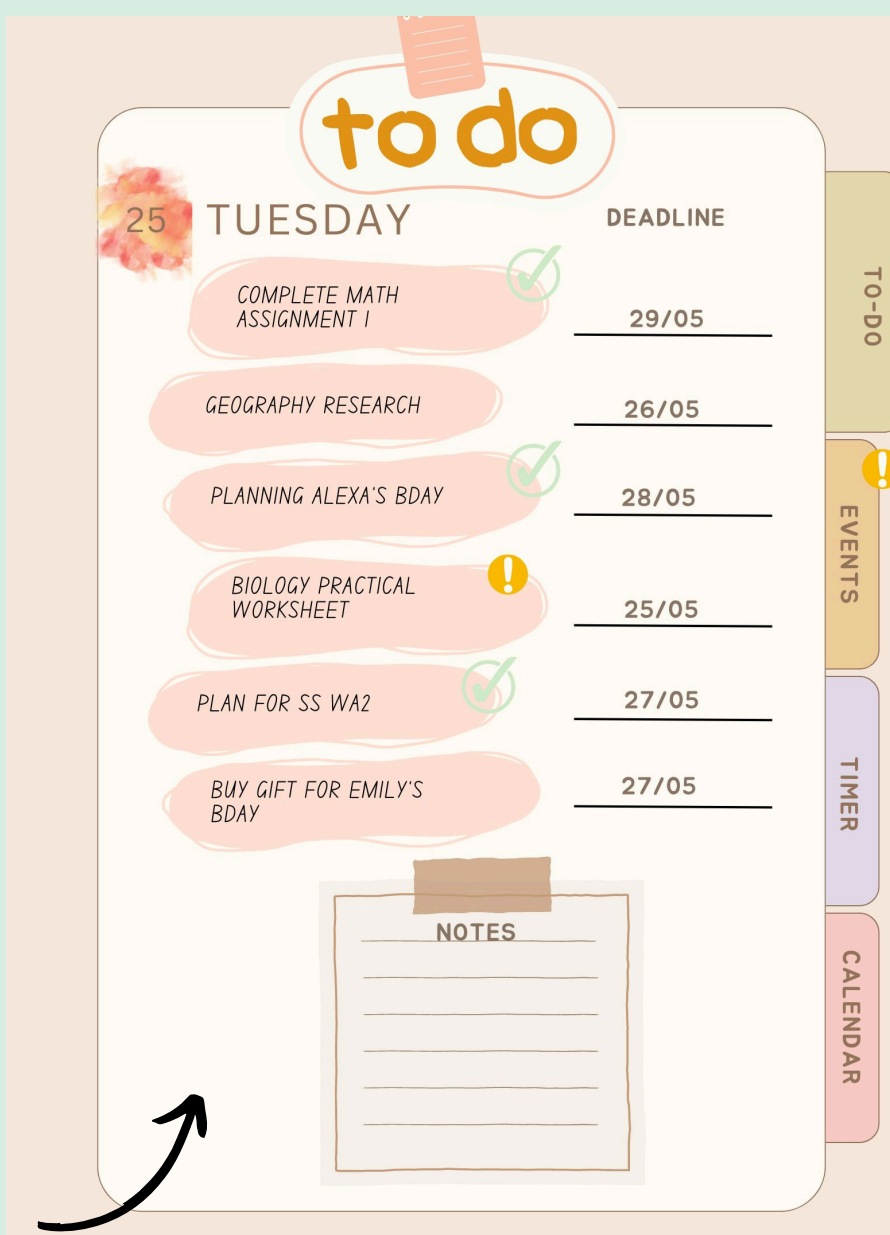

- Cute and aesthetically pleasing

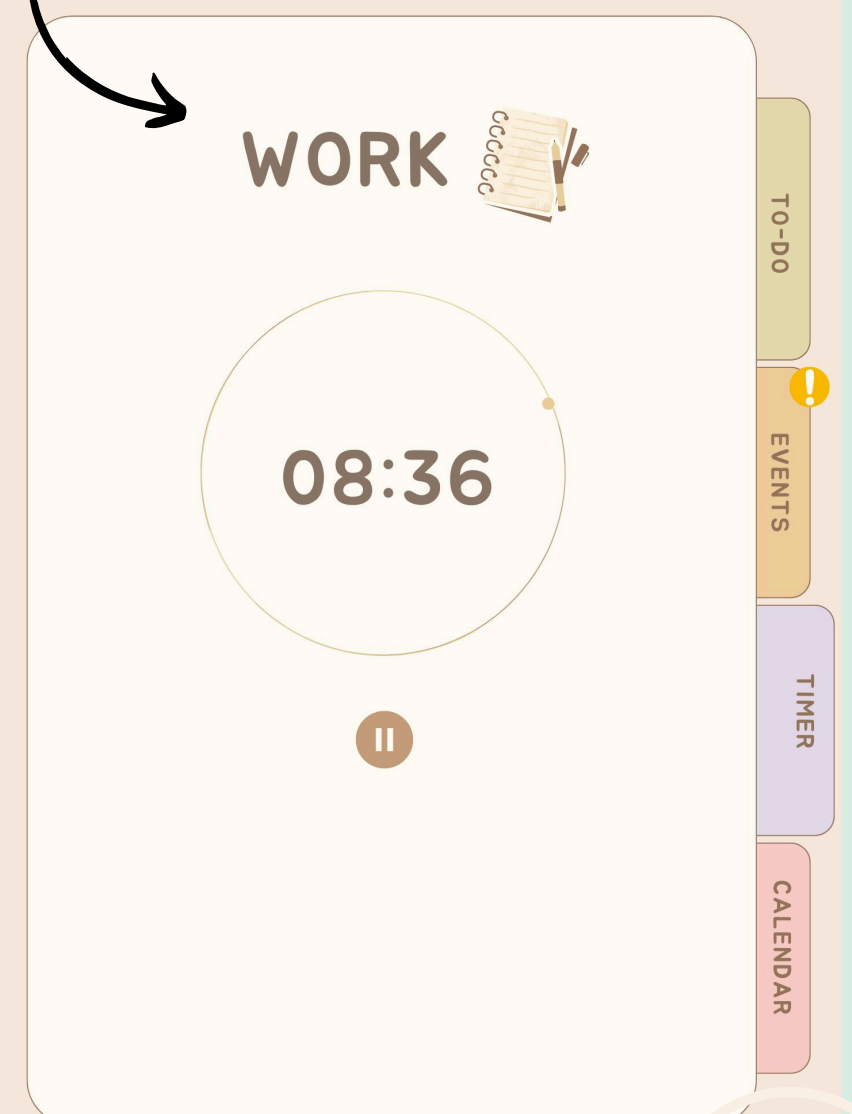
